A5225 Brand

- Widely grown fall dormancy 5 variety that fits aggressive harvest management systems where forage quality is key
- Strong nematode package for western producers. Resistance to Aphanomyces Race 2
- Adapted to U.S. production areas where fall dormancy 4 and 5 varieties are normally recommended, and where four or more annual harvests are made to maximize yield and milk per acre

Prairie Supreme Brand

- Top-yielding premium alfalfa with a 30/30 Wisconsin Disease Rating
- Comprised of plants selected from elite commercial varieties screened for winter hardiness, multiple pest resistance, forage quality and yield
- A fall dormancy 4, it's a great fit with three- and four-cut systems, as well as aggressive five-cut systems. It has a medium-early maturity to one-tenth flower and fast recovery after harvest

A4535 Brand

- Strong traffic compaction tolerance and yield with superior forage quality
- Fall dormancy 4 alfalfa, adapted to all U.S. production areas where fall dormancy 3, 4, or 5 varieties are recommended
- Expected to fit the traditional three- or four-cut harvest systems or rotational grazing programs. It has a medium maturity to one-tenth flower and an average rate of recovery to fit well with cool-season grasses or other legume mixtures
- 30/30 Wisconsin Disease Rating

50 Cal Brand

- Sunken crown set protects from equipment and animal traffic, along with severe winter weather
- Performs best in both well-drained, high-producing soils and less-than-ideal soils
- A solid disease, insect and nematode resistance package that helps defend itself in adverse environments

PB-500 Brand

- High-yielding alfalfa with fast regrowth after cutting. It displays excellent leafiness, high-percent crude protein and high relative feed value. Adapted to three or four cuts under aggressive management
- Solid pest resistance along with excellent winter hardiness
- Management tips: cut in spring at bud stage; cut every 28-38 days thereafter; graze or bale accumulated growth after frost; allow at least 21 days of regrowth before frost to prepare plants for winter

Prairie Hop II Brand

- Leafhopper-resistant variety with improved yield and forage quality
- Fall dormancy 3 alfalfa with a winter hardiness index of 2.2
- Medium-tall plant with a dense, leafy canopy. It will show medium-green foliage and a moderate multi-leaf expression
- Medium-late maturity with a 30/30 Wisconsin Disease Rating. It's well-suited for a three- to four-cut harvest or a rotational grazing system
